2. Fundraising Initiative

Upon learning of the financial burden placed on Neha's family, the alumni network initiated a rapid-response collection drive. The primary goal was to provide immediate "bridge funding" to ensure that her treatment was not delayed due to administrative or pharmaceutical costs.

4. Impact & Allocation

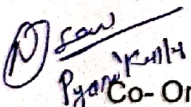
While the total medical costs for multi-organ failure are significantly higher, this initial collection of nine thousand serves several vital purposes:
