On February 02, NCC and the Eco club held their orientation programme on, "Preservation of Land and Forest Today."

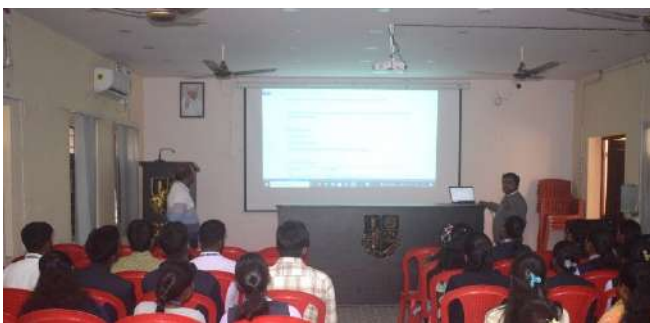
